<b>Walnut Block, Collectables, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough</b> <i>A crisp, fruity and refreshing Sauvignon Blanc with citrus and gooseberries notes. (13)</i>	<b>10</b>	<b>50</b>
<b>Domaine Thomas et Fils, Sancerre 'Le Pierrier', Loire, France</b> <i>Medium body. Hints of yellow plum, grapefruit blossom and green apple. (13)</i>		<b>52</b>
<b>Macon-Uchizy, Cave Talmard, Burgundy, France</b> <i>The result is really lovely wine - medium bodied in the mouth showing pear and apple flavours, with a crisp citrusy finish that lasts for ages.</i>		<b>50</b>
<b>Val de Vid, Verdejo, Rueda, Spain</b> <i>Fresh, elegant and smooth, but well structured. Tasty, aromatic and with easy entry into the mouth. Complex and persistent finish with pleasantly zesty touches as is typical of this variety.</i>		<b>42</b>
<b>William Fevre, Chablis, Burgundy, France</b> <i>Hints of refined bouquet of citrus and white flowers, entwined with a light mineral touch. Fresh, rich mouth, balanced by a good freshness. (13)</i>		<b>68</b>

## RED

<b>Paso del Sol, Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Valley, Chile</b>	<b>8.5</b>	<b>35</b>
<i>Soft and full bodied. Fruit driven style, with earthy notes, tobacco and chocolate hints. Well balanced with lovely ripe red and black fruits. (13)</i>		
<b>Chateau Meaume, Bordeaux Superior, France</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>38</b>
<i>Taut, muscular palate with lovely vibrancy and soft, rounded tannins, finishing with an herbal lift.</i>		
<b>Masi Passo Doble, Malbec and Corvina, Argentina</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>38</b>
<i>Rich and intense, full of cherries and berry fruit. Good length and soft tannins.</i>		
<b>Ca'di Ponti Nero d'Avola, Sicily, South Italy</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>39</b>
<i>Full-flavoured, spicy red fruit notes with aromas and tastes of ripe plum and black cherry. There are savoury, lightly smoky characters too, with a hint of bitter chocolate. (13)</i>		
<b>Il Buco, Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Italy</b>		<b>39</b>
<i>Lively, sweet wild cherry fruit with hints of spice and blackberry. Medium-bodied, well balanced with a ripe finish. (13)</i>		
<b>Domaine Boisson, Cotes du Rhone, Rhone Valley – France</b>		<b>43</b>
<i>Fruity fragrances of cherry and strawberry. Unpretentious with round and subtle qualities. (13)</i>		
<b>Montebuena Rioja, Crianza, Spain</b>	<b>11</b>	<b>45</b>
<i>Aromas of cherry and blackberry jam with a hint of wood that complement the fruity palate, with notes cinnamon and toasted vanilla.</i>		
<b>Santa Cristina, Chianti Superiore DOC, Tuscany, Italy</b>		<b>45</b>
<i>Complex nose, with notes of cherries and plums well integrated with toasted oak and vanilla. The palate is ample and supple with velvety tannins. (13)</i>		
<b>Walnut Block Collectables, Pinot Noir Organic, Marlborough, New Zealand</b>		<b>52</b>
<i>Fine aromas of red fruits and spice lead to a subtle, savoury palate. Display delicate fruits of Smoked strawberries and blackberries.</i>		
<b>Domaine Yann Chave, Organic, Crozes-Hermitage, Rhone Valley, France</b>		<b>62</b>
<i>Hints of forest fruits with a liquorice edge. A smooth palate with soft supple tannins that Culminate in a rich ripe finish. (13)</i>		
<b>Chateau Siran, Margaux Cru Bourgeois, Bordeaux, France</b>		<b>79</b>
<i>Aromas of liquorice, dark berries and blueberries. Full –bodied. With extremely well integrated tannins. In a word: vibrant!</i>		
<b>Chateau de Lescours Grand Cru, Saint-Émilion, France 2019</b>		<b>82</b>
<i>Dark garnet in colour with aromas of red and black fruits and earthy notes of forest floor, coffee and aromatic spices. Rich in fruit yet elegant and layered with savoury elements and silky tannins.</i>		
<b>Chateau de Lescours, Saint-Émilion, France 2015</b>		<b>160</b>
<i>Aromas of black plum, leather and mocha precede a dense palate of concentrated black fruits and dark chocolate and framed by fresh acidity and power fine tannins</i>		
<b>Masi Costasera Amarone, Valpolicella, Italy</b>		<b>127</b>
<i>Very dark ruby red in colour, with a nose of baked fruit, plums and cherries. Fruity tastes, with hints of coffee and cocoa. Very well balanced.</i>

<b>Corte delle Calli, Prosecco, Frizzante DOC, Italy</b>		<b>40</b>
<i>A bright straw yellow with greenish hints, aromas of golden apples and citrus fruits. (13)</i>		
<b>Prosecco Cuvee DOC Treviso, NV Corte delle Calli, Veneto, Italy</b>	<b>11.5</b>	<b>55</b>
<i>Fresh aromas on the nose, clean and intense. Convinces on the palate with fruity apple notes, Slightly floral and very elegant. Long lasting finish. (13)</i>		
<b>Cava Brut Seleccion, NV Villa Conchi, Catalonia, Spain</b>		<b>60</b>
<i>Elegant with fine bubbles. Good intensity on the nose with fruit aromas and toasted nuances. Pleasant and round with a long finish. (13)</i>		
<b>Gremillet Champagne, Brut Selection, NV</b>		<b>100</b>
<i>Fresh floral aromas mixed with characteristics toasty yeast overtones, balanced by richer Fruit and classic baked biscuit flavours, with a crisp citrus finish. (13)</i>		
<b>Veuve Clicquot Brut NV</b>		<b>140</b>
<i>Reconcile two opposing factors-strength and silkiness, and hold them in perfect balance with Aromatic intensity and a lot of freshness. (13)</i>		
<b>Dom Perignon, Brut NV</b>		<b>295</b>
<i>Aromas of almond and powdered cocoa that develop gradually into white fruits with hints of dried flowers. Classic toasted notes give a rounded finish and denote a fully realized maturity. The full taste lingers with the utmost elegance on a sappy, spicy note. (13)</i>
